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CHARGE

LAXMI, Vijaya, a Dentist, Statutory Exam 2013 BDS NTR University of Health Sciences 2000, is summoned to appear before the Professional Conduct Committee on Tuesday 7 April 2026 for an inquiry into the following charge:

The Charge:

“That being a registered dentist:

1. You allowed yourself to be recorded as a “witness” for JB who was undertaking a dental nursing sedation course when you did not comply with the responsibilities of that role, in that:
 - a) You did not observe JB carry out procedures and tasks relevant to her Practical Competence Assessment Sheets; and/or
 - b) You did not assess JB’s clinical skills competence using the Directly Observed Clinical Skills assessment tools.

2. You allowed yourself to be recorded as a “mentor” for JB who was undertaking a dental nurse sedation course when you did not comply with the responsibilities of that role in that:
 - a) You did not administrate JB’s clinical development and experience; and/or
 - b) You did not support JB’s clinical development and experience; and/or
 - c) You did not verify JB’s clinical development and experience; as far as these matters related to the practical components of JB’s dental nursing sedation course.

3. On or around those dates listed in Schedule 1, you provided JB with information and/or details from patient notes:
 - a) to assist JB to complete her coursework for her dental nursing sedation course in the knowledge that JB had not undertaken the necessary practical work and/or would be passing this off as her own work; and/or
 - b) for purposes other than that for which it was obtained and in breach of patient confidentiality.

4. Your actions in relation to allegation(s) 1 and/or 2, and/or 3, were;
 - a) Misleading; and/or,
 - b) Dishonest; and/or
 - c) Lacking in integrity.

AND, by reason of the matters alleged above, your fitness to practise is impaired by reason of your misconduct.”
