# **CHARGE**

Mario Egon GOMEZ SAGREDO, a dentist, Tandläkare Karolinska Institutet 2000, is summoned to appear before the Professional Conduct Committee on 11-15 and 22 August 2025 for an inquiry into the following charge:

"That being registered as a dentist:

- 1. Between 15 February 2022 and 24 May 2022 failed to provide an adequate standard of care to Patient A by
  - a. not adequately communicating the treatment plan to the Patient A; and/or
  - b. not ensuring that Patient A understood the risks of extraction, including the risk of fracturing of the teeth and root retention.
- 2. Between 15 February 2022 and 24 May 2022 failed to obtain informed consent for treatment provided to Patient A.
- 3. Between 31 March 2022 and 24 May 2022, you failed to act in accordance with your duty of candour, by failing to inform Patient A of the fracturing of his teeth and root retention, following extraction procedures.
- You submitted inappropriate claims for treatment conducted for Patient A, in that you claimed for two Band B treatments when you were only entitled to claim for one.
- 5. Your conduct in relation to 4. was:
  - a. Misleading
  - b. Dishonest

AND THAT your fitness to practice is impaired by reason of your misconduct."
