CHARGE

Jaykrishan SASDEV, a dentist, BDS King's College London 2021, is summoned to appear before the Professional Conduct Committee on 13 July 2026 for an inquiry into the following charge:

“That, being a registered dentist

1. You failed to provide an adequate standard of care to Patient A on 1 February 2024 in that you:
 - a. administered additional increments of midazolam intravenously throughout the extraction of Patient A’s tooth at LL8;
 - b. used a patient waiting area as a recovery area;
 - c. did not ensure that Patient A’s immediate recovery period was supervised by an appropriately trained and/or experienced member of staff;
 - d. allowed Patient A to leave the practice in an unfit state.
2. On 1 February 2024, you conducted an extraction of Patient A’s tooth at LL8 with colleagues who you knew, or ought to have known, had not been adequately trained and/or experienced in dental sedation.
3. Your actions at paragraphs 1(a) and/or 1(b) and/or 1(c) and/or 1(d) and/or 2 harmed Patient A or put Patient A at risk of harm.

And that, by reason of the facts alleged, your fitness to practice is impaired by reason of your Misconduct.”
