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## CHARGE

Ajzelina ZEK CER, a dentist, D Stom Katowice 2004, is summoned to appear before the Professional Conduct Committee on 27 May 2025 for an inquiry into the following charge:

“That being a registered dentist:

1. You failed to provide an adequate standard of care to Patient A from around 11/04/2022 to 03/07/2023 by:
  - a) not carrying out adequate analysis of pre-treatment CBCT scans;
  - b) not diagnosing an area of infection around the root of the upper left central incisor visible on two CBCT scans;
  - c) not discussing options for treatment and/or referral of the infection around the root of the upper left central incisor;
  - d) not carrying out sufficient treatment planning;
  - e) by not discussing the material risks and/or benefits of the proposed bridge treatment;
  - f) by providing a new bridge supported by the infected upper left central incisor;
  - g) your radiographic practice, in that you:
    - i. imaged a larger area than was clinically justified in both the upper and lower jaw on two occasions;
    - ii. failed to report on the findings of the CBCT scans.
2. You failed to maintain an adequate standard of record keeping in respect of Patient A's appointments from 11/04/2022 to 03/07/2023.
3. You failed to obtain informed consent in respect of bridge treatment and / or costs of bridge treatment.
  - a) because the bridge on the left side, supported by the infected incisor would not be considered clinically appropriate; and
  - b) costs were not provided prior to the commencement of the treatment for the right-side bridge
4. You provided dental treatment without adequate support.
5. Your actions in respect of Allegation 4 above put patient safety at risk.

AND that by reason of the matters alleged above, your fitness to practise is impaired by reason of misconduct.”
