CHARGE

JIMINEZ, Adriana, a dental nurse, National Certificate NEBDN 2009, is summoned to appear before the Professional Conduct Committee on 18 September 2023 for an inquiry into the following charge:

“That being a registered dental care professional:

1. Between in or around September 2018 and in or around December 2018 you provided treatment to patients outside your scope of practice, including:
 - a) Intra-oral examination;
 - b) Extra-oral examination;
 - c) Removal of gingival deposits;
 - d) Root planning;
 - e) Manual debridement;
 - f) Periodontal pocket charting;
 - g) Cleaning around implants;
 - h) Oral hygiene instruction;
 - i) Using rubber dam;
 - j) Applying topical fluoride products;
 - k) Placing temporary fillings;
 - l) Temporary cementation of crowns;
 - m) Removal of dental staining;
 - n) Teeth whitening;
 - o) Alginate impressions.
2. Between in or around September 2018 and in or around December 2018 you provided dental treatment and / or services without adequate indemnity cover.
3. By your conduct set out at paragraphs 1 and 2 above you have put patients at risk.

AND as a result of the matters alleged your fitness to practise is impaired by reason of misconduct.”
