CHARGE

MOHAMMAD BANY, Mustafa Bataineh, a dentist, Lic Odont Universidad Europea De Madrid 2018 is summoned to appear before the Professional Conduct Committee on 07 September 2026 for an inquiry into the following charge:

"That being a registered dentist:

1. *Between 30 September 2022 and 31 August 2024 at Practice 1 and / or at Practice 2 you failed to maintain an adequate standard of care for Patient 1 in that:*
 - a. *You did not discuss, adequately or at all:*
 - i. *alternative treatment options for treatment provided to the UR4 – UL4;*
 - ii. *risks and benefits of veneers and/or crowns, prior to fitting on 01 March 2024;*
2. *As a result of your conduct at 1(a) above, you failed to obtain the patient's valid consent for treatment.*
3. *Between 05 August 2023 and 14 March 2024 at Practice 1 and / or at Practice 2 you failed to maintain an adequate standard of care for Patient 2 in that you did not provide appropriate aftercare in relation to the arrangements for ongoing care.*
4. *Between 05 August 2023 and 20 February 2024 at Practice 1 you failed to maintain an adequate standard of record keeping for Patient 2 in that you did not make any or any adequate notes of the appointments.*
5. *On or around 21 February 2024 you requested that the laboratory delay delivery of Patient 3's denture.*
6. *Your conduct at 5 above, was:*
 - a. *Unprofessional*
 - b. *Not in the patient's best interests*
 - c. *Resulted in inconvenience and / or an increased risk of harm to the patient, by delaying subsequent planned treatment.*
7. *On or around 17 February 2024 you appropriated materials from Practice 1, for use at Practice 2.*
8. *Your conduct at 7 above was:*
 - a. *Misleading as it suggested you had permission to use materials from Practice 1 at another clinic*
 - b. *Dishonest, as you knew you did not have permission from Practice 1 to use the materials elsewhere*
9. *On or between February and March 2024 you asked the receptionist of Practice 1 to provide you with confidential patient contact information.*
10. *Your conduct at 9 above disregarded patient confidentiality.*

11. On or before 17 February 2024 you:
 - a. Requested that Practice 1 cancel your appointments for that day, as you could not work due to an emergency;
 - b. Provided treatment to a patient at Practice 2.
12. Your conduct at 11(a) above was:
 - a. Misleading as you had suggested you were unavailable for work
 - b. Dishonest, as you knew you were going to provide treatment on that date from another practice
13. On 17 February 2024 at Practice 2 you said the following to Colleague A:
 - a. '[Colleague A], you owe me a gift', or words to that effect
 - b. 'Do me a blowjob', or words to that effect
 - c. 'Get on your knees and blow me off', or words to that effect
14. On 17 February 2024 whilst making the comments to Colleague A, as set out at 13 above, you gestured towards your genitalia.
15. Your conduct at 13 and 14 above was:
 - a. Inappropriate
 - b. Unprofessional
 - c. Sexually motivated

AND that by reason of the matters alleged above, your fitness to practise is impaired by reason of your misconduct."
