### Charges

MONAGHAN, Lauren Michelle, a Dental Nurse, National Diploma in Dental Nursing NEBDN 2015, is summoned to appear before the Professional Conduct Committee on 12 May 2025 for an inquiry into the following charge and amended on 13 May 2025:

# Amended Charges (Amended on 13 May 2025)

'That being registered as a dental care professional:

- Between 1 December 2021 and 31 December 2021, you provided a Botox treatment, at a [Redacted] dental practice without the knowledge and/or permission of your employer.
- 2. You provided Botox treatment to Person 1 in the absence of:
  - a. A face to face assessment of Person 1 by a qualified individual for the purposes of issuing a prescription; and/or
  - b. A valid prescription in the name of Person 1; and/or
  - c. Valid insurance for the treatment provided.
- 3. By your conduct at paragraph 2 above you have put a patient at risk.
- 4. You failed to maintain an adequate standard of record keeping for the Botox treatment provided.
- 5. During a meeting held with her employer, [Redacted], on 12 April 2022, you denied carrying out a Botox procedure.
- 6. Your conduct at paragraph 5 was:
  - a. Misleading and/or
  - b. Dishonest.

AND as a result of the above matters alleged your fitness to practise is impaired by reason of Misconduct.'
