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CHARGE

Fazeela KHAN-OSBORNE, a dentist, DiplImpDent Royal College of Surgeons Of England 2007, MSc Lond 1999, BDS Lond 1994, LDS Royal College of Surgeons Of England 199, BSc Lond 1989, is summoned to appear before the Professional Conduct Committee on 1 September 2026 for an inquiry into the following charge:

'Being a registered dentist and whilst the Principal Dentist and owner of the One to One Dental Clinic ("the Practice"):

1. *Between 22 September and 8 December 2016, your communications with Person A and/or other members of staff included:*
 - (a) shouting and/or using a raised voice;*
 - (b) speaking in an aggressive manner; and/or*
 - (c) being dismissive.*

2. *On or around 5 July 2019, your communications with Person B included:*
 - (a) shouting;*
 - (b) swearing;*
 - (c) speaking in a belittling manner; and/or*
 - (d) using an aggressive tone.*

3. *Between approximately January and April 2023, your communications with Person C, Person D and/or other members of staff, included:*
 - (a) using a raised tone of voice and/or shouting;*
 - (b) swearing; and/or*
 - (c) speaking in a belittling manner.*

4. *Your conduct as set out at paragraphs 1, 2 and/or 3 above was:*
 - (a) disrespectful;*
 - (b) unprofessional; and/or*
 - (c) intimidating.*

And, by reason of the facts stated above, your fitness to practise as a dentist is impaired by reason of misconduct.'
